


TEXAS RIO GRANDE VALLEY WOODCARVERS

2019 JUDGING RULES

1. Entry forms for the judging competition will be in the table registration envelope that you will receive on Thursday afternoon. Please fill them out and sign them prior to checking in at the judging table. Carvers are to select category and division for their entries. They may be reclassified at the judge's discretion. **2. Registration of carvings for judging will only be accepted Thursday, January 17, 2019, beginning at 1:00 P.M. and closing promptly at 5:00 P.M. Carvers with tables must check in at the main entrance, when you bring your carvings for setup or judging. A name badge, provided in your packet, will be required for free admission. This will be the same for both exhibitors and non-exhibitors.**
3. Items to be judged must be made by the carver not more than 2 years prior to the show. *Show personnel may remove a carving from competition, if it is found not to be in accordance with show rules.*
4. Carvings that contain multiple pieces must be contained on a single base.
5. *Any name, initials, or signature on the carving should be covered.*
6. *No more than two (2) carvings may be entered in any category.*
7. *Mentored/instructor assisted carvings must be entered into the appropriate Instructor Assisted Category (#600). This includes working with an instructor outside of a class setting. **Instructor assisted carvings are not eligible for Best of Division or Best of Show.***
8. Ribbons will be awarded at the **discretion of the judges**, per their criteria. *The judges will be asked to explain to competitors how they might improve their carving(s). Every effort will be made to list comments for each carving.*
9. All entries in the competition must be left on the judging tables for the duration of the show. You will need your claim ticket to pick up your entry at the close of the show--- **DON'T LOSE IT!**
10. If there are too few entries in a category they may be moved to the nearest category. Judge(s) may add a class to assist with judging.
11. An entry must contain a significant amount of carving to be considered for Best of Show. The Competition Chairperson and the Judge(s) will decide if the piece qualifies. Their decision is **FINAL**.
12. Best of Division will be awarded in the Open, Intermediate, and Novice Divisions. Overall Best of Show will be chosen from the three Best of Division winners.
13. **The top finishers, Best of Show, Peoples' Choice, and Carvers' will be awarded Commemorative Knives, engraved and dated, rather than ribbons.**
